The start times are as follows:

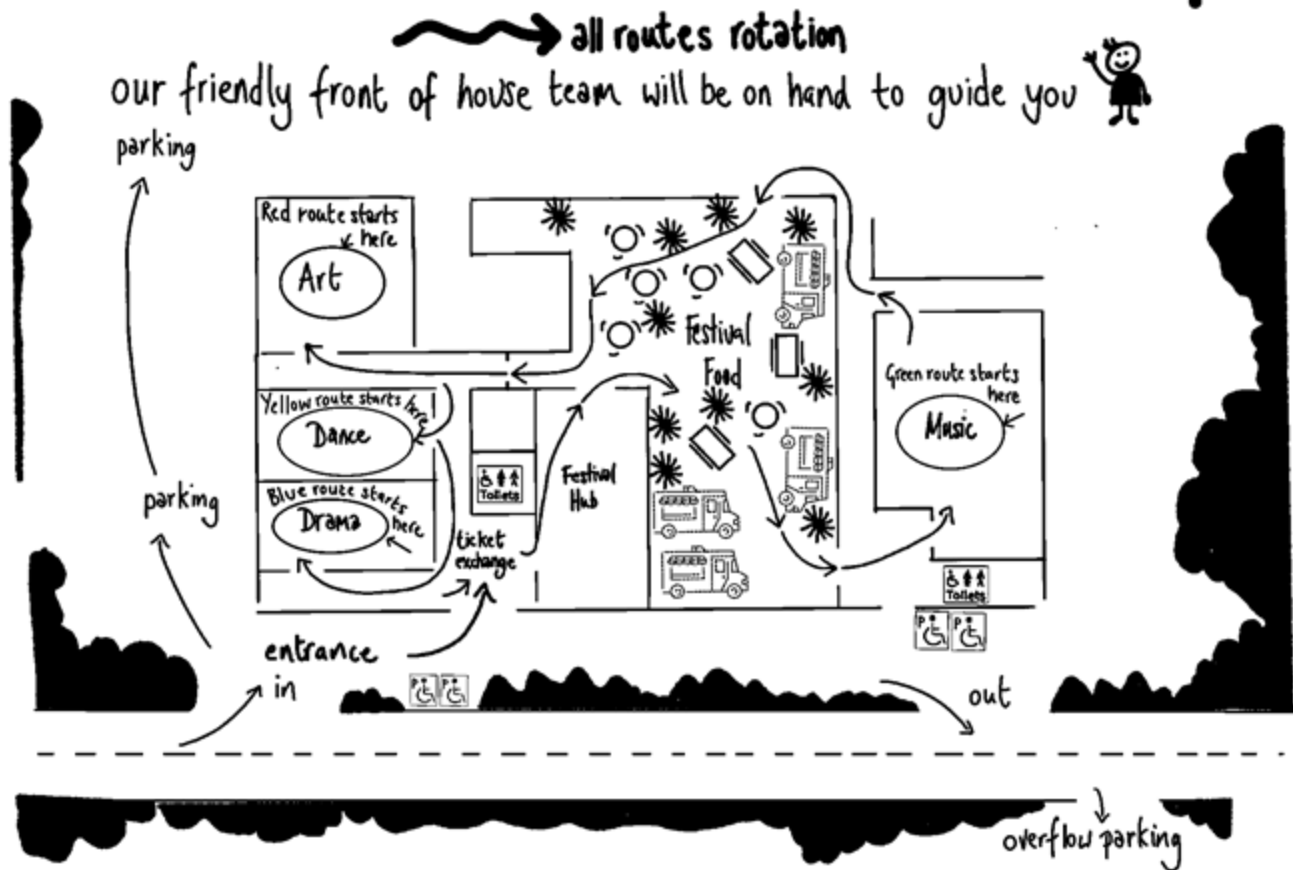
Venue 1: 7.00 pm
