HOAX EMERGENCY SERVICE CALLS

We have been asked to make you aware that a number of hoax emergency service calls have been made recently in the Huntington and New Earswick area. We would be grateful if you could discuss the implications of making hoax calls with your child, along with outlining the risk that misdirection of these services can have on a real emergency.

It is worth noting that it is illegal to make hoax calls which could carry a fine of up to £2,500 if caught.
